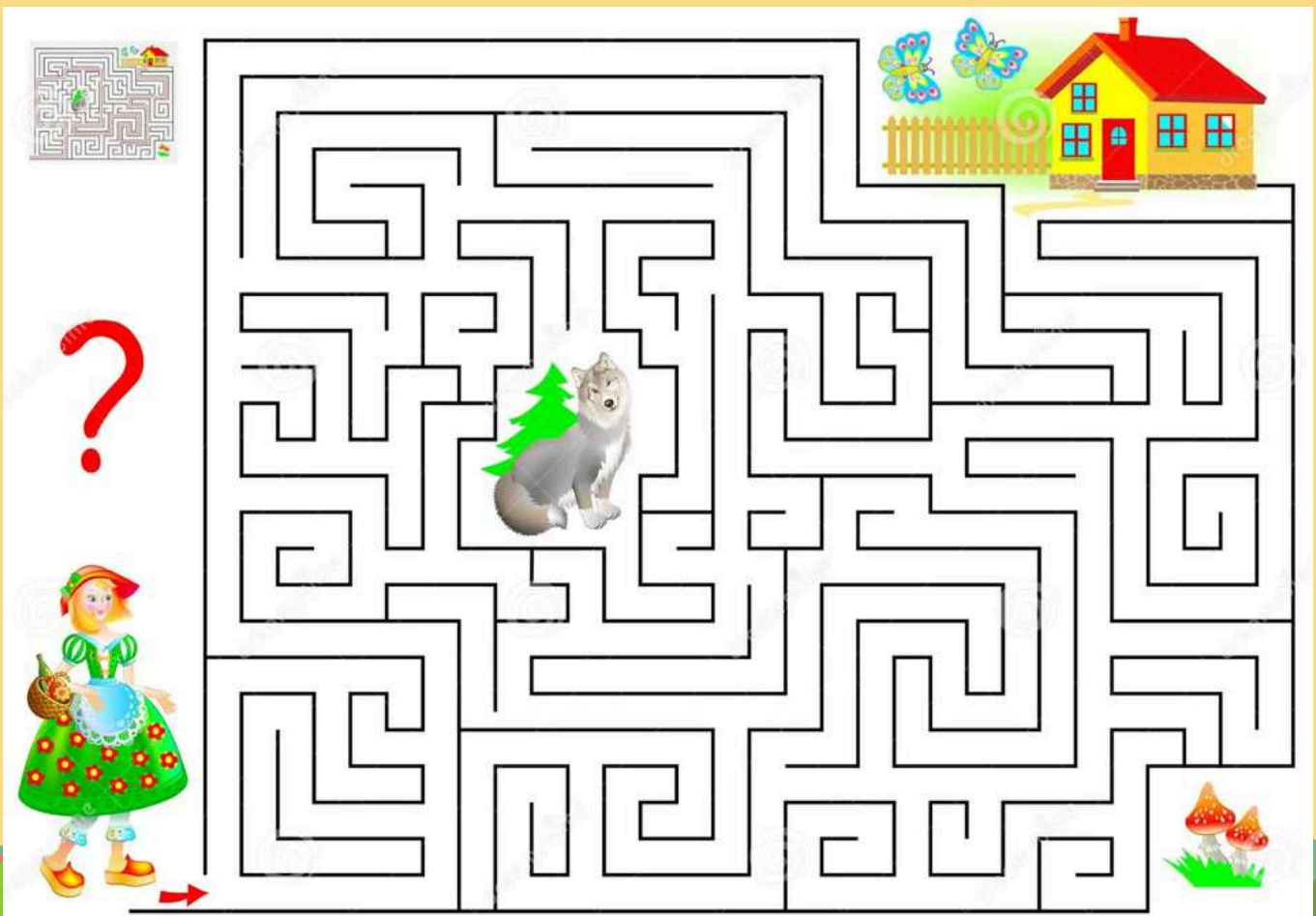

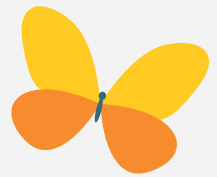

Do you know you can wire your child's brain for happiness?

Hello dear parents,
Welcome back! So We're with some more exciting tips to enhance our parenting journey.
Let's learn today 7 daily practices to train your child to be happier

1) **Gratitude journaling:**

Make your child maintain a journal where they write everyday 3 things they are grateful for each day.

Science behind this: This wires and trains kids' brains for happiness and resilience by emphasizing positive emotions and experiences.

2) **Daily nature time:** Let your child play outdoors, either in the garden, park etc.

Science behind this: This reduces stress, improves mood, and contributes to their overall emotional and mental health.

3) **Physical activity:**

Allow your child to play, run around, which will help release the pent up emotions during the day.

Science behind this: Exercise or play which has physical activity releases endorphins, which are natural mood lifters.

4) **3:1 Positive negative ratio**

Give your child three positive encouragements for every one disciplinary action or negative feedback.

Science behind this: this fosters a secure attachment and emotional resilience.

5) **Act of kindness**

Use a kindness or create a kindness jar to keep track of the kind things your child does each day.

Create a calming bedtime routine with activities like reading, soothing music, meditation, expressing gratitude for the day.

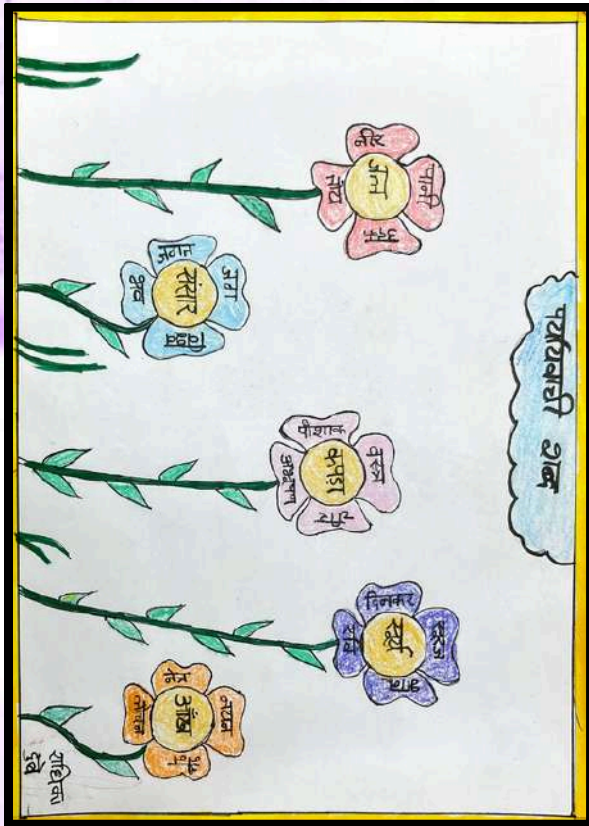
Science behind this: This improves sleep quality and enhances emotional well being in children.
