Celebrating the splendours of Summer

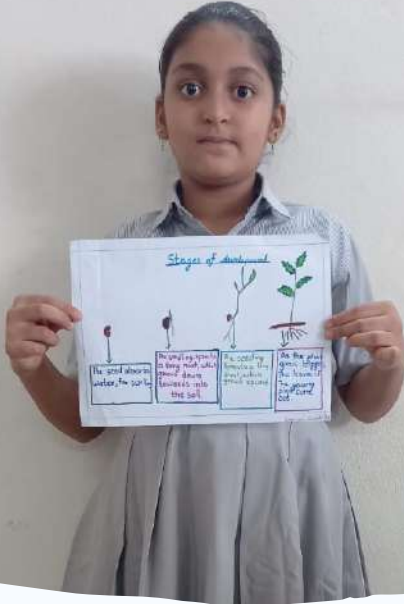
Young learners of pre-primary had a joyous celebration of the summer season where they explored and immersed themselves in understanding various aspects of the season while enjoying the treats of the season.
