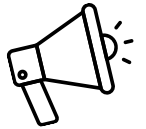
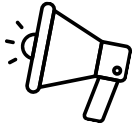

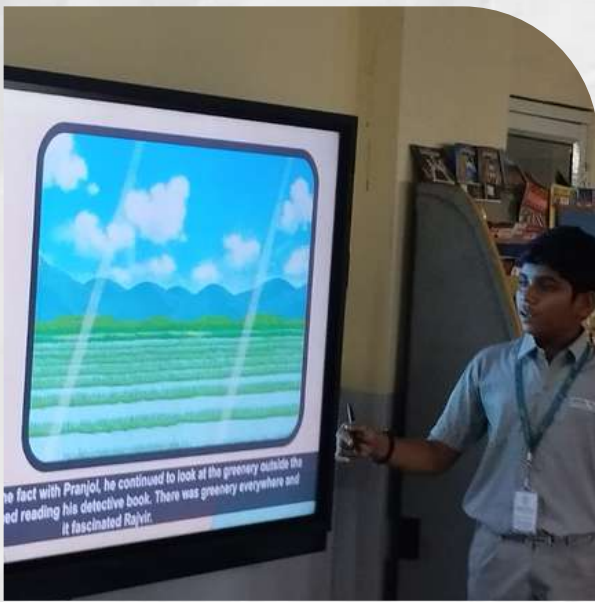


## CHILDREN'S DAY SPECTACLE

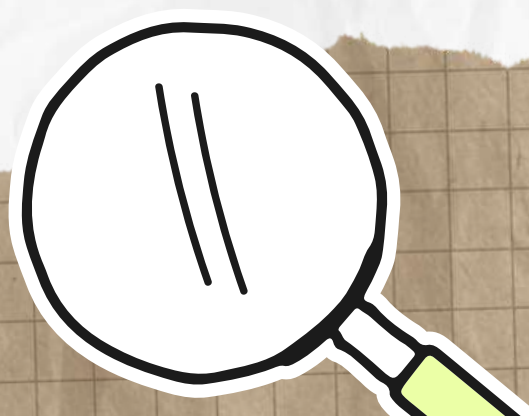


## STUDENT-LED CONFERENCE

### 4 A LITTLE SEED

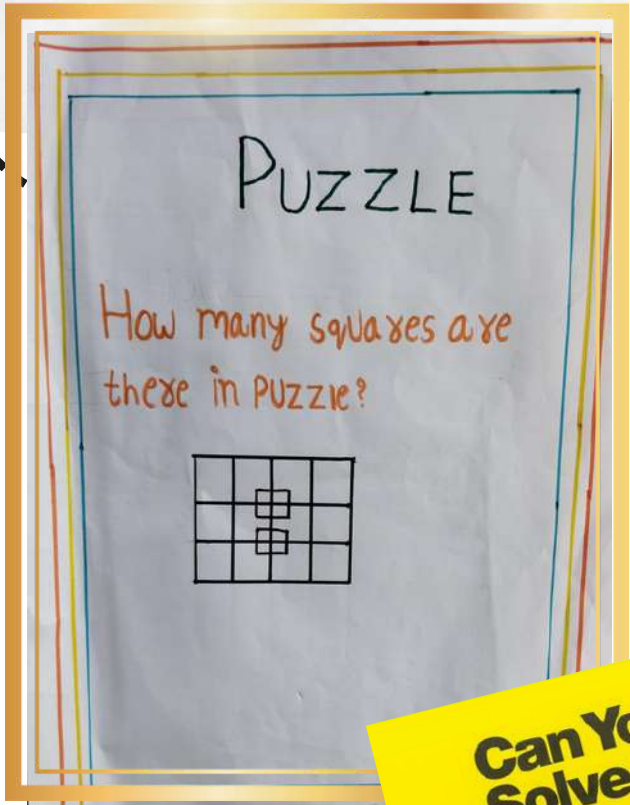
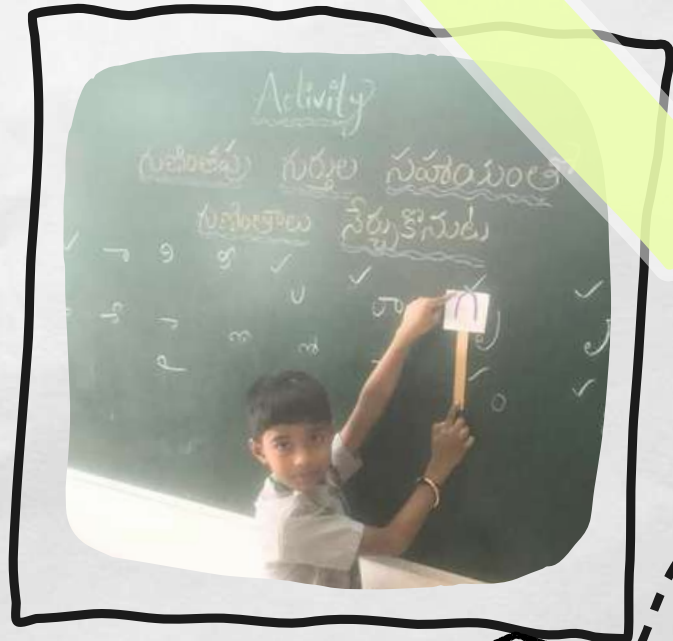
Grade 1 students explored the growth of plants from seeds, learning how to nurture and care for plants for optimal health.





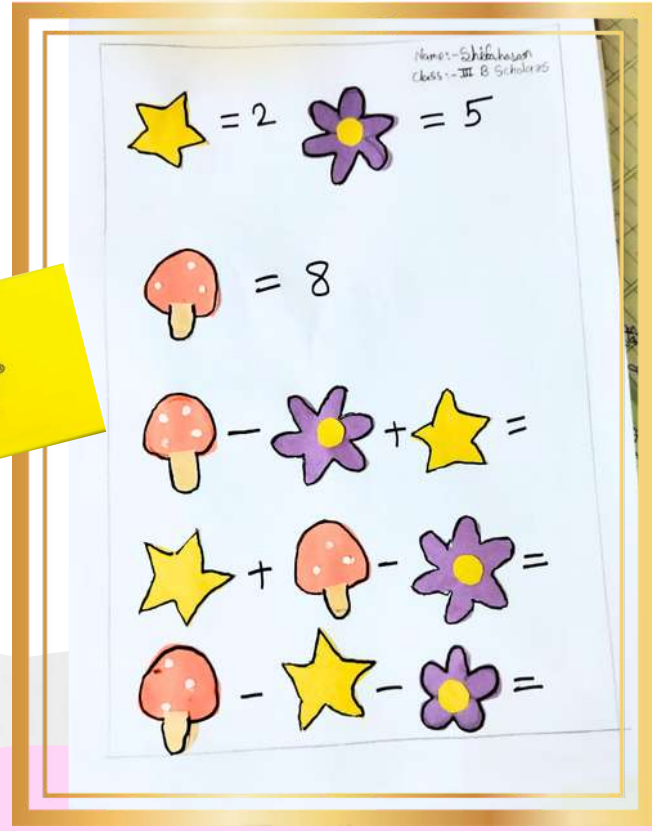

## FLOWER ANATOMY AND SEED FORMATION

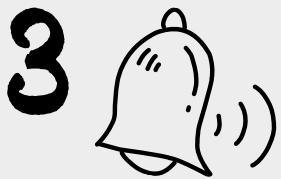
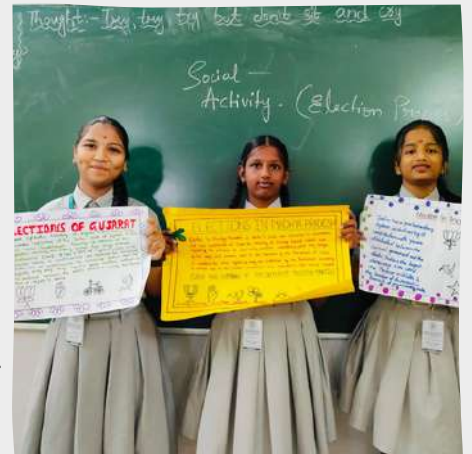


Grade 7 students explored the different parts of a flower and learned how specific components undergo transformation to develop into fruits and seeds, deepening their understanding of plant life cycles.

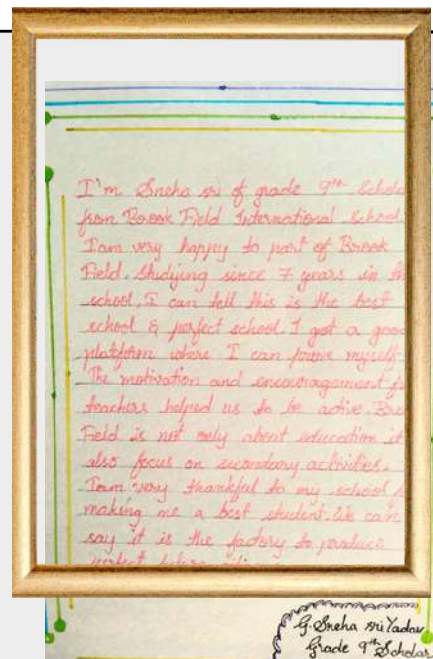
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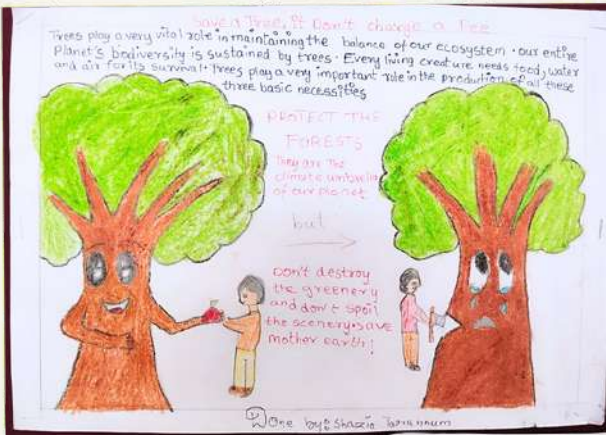
